## P R E F A C E

A half yearly Island wide Sample Survey was conducted twice a year from September, 1972 to September 1974 and from 1975 onwards the survey was conducted only once a year by the Department of Labour as part of a U.N.D.P/I.L.O project for the development of "Labour Statistics.

About 1750 establishments with five or more employees were selected for the survey on a scientific basis from the frame of the Employment Survey. The data relating to employment, man days and hours worked earnings and further detailed statistics were collected from each of the selected establishments. These data were collected by the Programming Assistants of the Statistics Branch of the Department of Labour who were attached to the various A.C.L. Districts.

Since this was the 6th series of this type of report it was decided to give only the more important statistical tables with brief analytical notes.

I wish to thank the managements of the sampled establishments who readily gave their cooperation to our field officers to complete the schedules the officers of the Statistics Branch of this Department who collected and analysed the data and also the officers of the Data Processing Division of Census and Statistics who undertook the computerisation of the data.

Sample Survey of Earnings, Hours of Work - June 1977

## Introduction

In terms of a UNDP/ILO project for the development of our Statistics the Department of Labour initiated a half yearly Sample Survey in September 1972. This report is the sixth one of the series of this type of reports. The purpose of the survey is to collect data on earnings and hours of work for the major eight Occupational Categories under 22 selected groups of the Industrial Classification. From 1972 to 1975 this survey was conducted twice a year with reference periods as March and September. However in the year 1975 the survey was carried out only once, the reference period being March 1975. Since 1976 the reference period of the survey was changed to the month of June.

In addition to the survey of Earnings and hours of Work an ancillary survey of Labour Conditions was also conducted in the year 1977. The results of this survey will be published later. The information for both surveys was collected for the reference month of June from the same sampled establishments selected for the year 1977.

The objects concepts, definitions, sample design and limitations of the survey have been already discussed in the past reports of this survey. Certain modifications and improvements were done in the year 1975 and since then the survey was conducted with these improvements done in the year 1975.

The survey covers a sample of larger establishments with five or more paid employees engaged in productive, distributive, construction transport, storage and other business activities like Finance, Insurance, Business Services etc. which come under the broad definition of "Industries". A probability sample of about 1750 establishments were selected for the survey from some 12,000 establishments, the frame being the responding establishments of the Annual Employment Survey 1976. The method of stratified random sampling was adopted to select the establishments such that the sample will be optimum in size to give the estimates a predetermined degree of precision which was fixed at 5% error at 95% confidence limits.

Table 1 of the Statistical Appendix gives the number of responding establishments for the survey conducted in June 1977. Altogether 1759 establishments were selected for the survey and of these the schedules for the earnings and hours of work survey were completed by 1556 establishments. The survey commenced in the month of July 1977 and field operations were completed by the first quarter of the year 1978. Editing and Coding of the schedules were done during the second half of the year 1978, and sent to the Computer Division of the Department of Census and Statistics for processing.

As in the other surveys arrangements were made to minimize the errors in the field and during the coding and editing stages. Specially trained supervisory staff checked the data collected by field staff and the schedules were rechecked by the editing unit before computerisation.

The final computer printouts after corrections were received from the Computer Division in July 1979 according to private and public sector separately and both sectors together for all industry as well as for all size strata within each industry. 56 Tables for the appendix and 10 tables for the text were prepared from the computerised tables which were given in the report.

Short analytical notes on the Survey of Earnings and Hours of Work - June 1977

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Table 1 of the Statistical Appendix shows the position of response and the distribution of establishments by industry. Tables numbered 2 to 28 and 29 to 55 give statistics of estimated employment, average number of days worked, days paid for but not worked, average number of hours worked (both normal and overtime separately), average earnings per employee and percentage of payments in kind to total remuneration by industries and within each industry by Major Occupational Categories. Tables 56 also gives the comparison of statistics of total employment, total cash payments, average monthly earnings for June 1976 and June 1977 by major industries and within each industry by Major Occupational Categories.

It has been decided this year to give in the Statistical Appendix only the more important tables which were prepared from the computer printouts and in addition ten other tables extracted from these tables of the Statistical Appendix along with brief analytical notes. Tables I and II show the Index numbers calculated for June '77 (base period as Sept '74) by Major Division of Industry and Major Occupational Categories. Laspeyres method was used to calculate the Index Numbers. Last column of the Tables gives the percentage rise from Sept '72 to June '77 for each major industry and Occupational Category. It will be seen that the overall Index for June '77 (For all occupational categories and industries) is 144.6 while it was 101.1 for June '76. This was an increase by 94.1 percent from 74.5 in September '72 to 144.6 in June '77.

The total monthly wages and salary bill given in tables III-A, III-B and III-C consisted of basic salaries, special allowance, overtime and other cash payments. About Rs.250 million was recorded as the wage bill for the total number employed or about 1.0 million. The total wage bill was about Rs.192 million in the public sector in which the employment was about 0.8 million. While it was about Rs.66 million and employment about 0.2 million in the Private Sector. Of the monthly wage and salary bill for both sectors, the industry 'Agriculture' was the highest with Rs.74.6 million and it was lowest in the industry 'Mining and Quarrying" with Rs.1.2 million. The total wage bill for June '77 for all industries was recorded as Rs.250 million as against the total wage bill Rs.175 million for June '76.

Comparison of earnings and man days and hours worked for June '77 with June '76 are given in the tables IV and VI by major industry divisions and by Major Occupational Categories respectively. Tables V and VII show the comparison of earnings, mandays and hours worked for private and public sectors by major industries and major occupational categories. Table VIII compares the average earnings per employee, average man-days worked and average number of hours worked per day for private and public sectors by each industry in respect of manual workers "manual workers consisted of foremen and supervisors skilled and semi-skilled workers and unskilled workers.

Average earnings by Major Industries according to five size groups of employees viz 5-25, 26-100, 101-500, 501-1000 and over 1000 are given in the table IX. Table X shows the average earnings by Major Industry Divisions for white collar workers and other workers. White collar workers are those in the categories Administrative, Managerial, Professional and Technical and Clerical and Sales workers while "other workers" include Foremen and Supervisors, Skilled and Unskilled and Young and Child workers. Another interesting fact that emerged was the large difference in the earnings of the "White Collar" workers and the "other workers" in certain industrial categories such as Agriculture, Mining and Quarrying, Manufacturing, Construction, Trade, Hotel and Restaurant, Transport, Communications, Power and Gas, Water Supply, Sewerage, Drainage and Solid Waste Management, and Other Services.
