Occupation in Agriculture

The question of operators who work less than 50% in agriculture was discussed. D.U. & S. stressed the importance of such operators' other activities and their occupation. It was decided to enter this question in addition to question 5 in A. C. 3.

Fertilizer

Decided to collect only chemical fertilizer, lime gypsum and other in A. C. 3 schedule.

Staff

Additional staff to the unit was taken and decided to discuss with the A. D. (H.C.) later.

Finance

After spending for the Pilot Survey the balance money out of this year's vote to purchase necessary papers to print schedules for the Census proper was decided, and also to look for any unspent money in other votes to be used in purchasing of the printing paper this year.
