P R E F A C E

The Sample Survey on Employment, Earnings and Hours of Work, has been an on-going annual exercise since it was initiated in 1972 with UNDP/ILO assistance under technical advice from ILO. The survey which is a random probability sample has as its objectives, the collection of data in the field of Labour Statistics, pertaining to Employment, Mandays and Hours worked, Wages and Salaries etc. The above data was canvassed under eight broad based Occupational categories. This is the tenth report published in the series.

Programming Assistants, who served as the field staff for this survey and are attached to both the Head office and the regional A.C.L. offices, personally visited the sampled establishments numbering nearly 1,600 ; to collect the data. This publication gives data relevant to the survey results for June 1983. The various stages, such as sampling, data collection, editing, coding and tabulation took a lot of time in the preparation of this report. However it should be remembered that this is the only publication embodying Labour statistics on the subjects covered.

I wish to record my appreciation of the employers and heads of the selected establishments who co-operated by making their records readily available to my field staff for scrutiny and extraction of data for the questionnaire. I also wish to express my thanks to the Data Processing Division of the Dept. of Census and Statistics for the preparation of the final tables expeditiously. My thanks are also due to the staff of the Statistics Branch for their co-operation at the various stages of this publication.

Mr. H. Halwela, Statistical Officer, who has since retired from service attended to the preliminary work whilst Mr. D. Calyaneratne, Statistical Officer, was in charge of the Sample Survey unit from then onwards. Messers A. Kahanda and J. K. G. J. Perera, Statisticians were in overall charge, providing the necessary guidance and technical advice. I thank them all.

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## INTRODUCTION

I

This is the tenth report published on the Sample Survey of Earnings and Hours of Work, since 1972. This survey for collecting labour statistics in detail, with the assistance of UNDP/ILO project commenced in 1972, with the Employment Survey frame of 1971 as the base. Since then the selection of establishments for the Sample Survey each year was purely dependant on the frame of the preceding year's Employment Survey. From the initial stage up to 1974, the survey was conducted bi-annually; collecting statistics on Earnings, man-hours worked and related matters such as number of days, shifts worked, occupational distribution of employees, systems of wage payments, pay periods etc. Since 1975 the survey is being conducted once a year, taking the reference month as June each year. The form used was also modified to collect statistics on employment, man days and hours worked, leave, wages and salaries etc. Under-eight broad occupational categories.

Stratified random sampling method was adopted for selection of sample. After studying the Industry pattern that prevailed in the country and taking into consideration the industries covered by Wages Boards and overall cost, entire industries were grouped together into 22 sub-industries under 9 major industrial categories. Then, each industry was divided into several size strata, taking into consideration the homogeneity within the size strata. Establishments having over 100 employees in respect of 18 industries and those having over 1000 employees in respect of 3 Industries were taken into the survey without being sampled. Other establishments were put into size strata considering employment as follows: 5-25 employees; 26-100 for the 18 Industries and in the other 3 the size strata were 5-25; 26-100; 101-500; and 501-1000. Then the sample size for each strata were calculated in such a way that the total sample will be of optimum size. This will enable us to prepare estimates with the predetermined degree of precision which was fixed at  $\pm 5\%$  error at 95% confidence limit. Altogether, around 1600 establishments were selected to the sample.

Sampling selection, data collection, editing & coding of completed schedules, data processing, preparation of final tables, took two to three years in the completion of this report. There could be a certain amount of sampling and non-sampling errors arising out of this long process. However, several steps such as 25% field supervision by supervisory staff, editing & coding, close-checking at the data processing stage etc. helped to minimise the above errors. However some of the estimates have to be dealt with caution as some fluctuations were noticed in the estimated employment and earnings in certain occupational categories under some Sub industries in comparison with past figures.

S. S. used in data collection of the survey

Difinitions and concepts used in data collection of the survey have been given in previous reports and the user is advised to refer to them if necessary.

A total of 54 tables are given in the appendix. Table 1 to 27 are for both public and private sectors combined while the tables numbered from 28 to 54 are for the two sectors separately. Table 1 gives the response to the survey and the sample selection for (employees over 100 above cut-off point) and less than 100 below cut-off point establishments by industries. Ten tables extracted from the final print-out of the survey results are also given in the text of the report.

Table 1 gives the comparison of Employment data between the EMPLOYMENT SURVEY 1983 with the estimated data of the SAMPLE SURVEY for Major Industries by Sectors. It can be seen that the total estimated employment figure is approximately 1,000,000, where it shows a remarkable increase over the corresponding Employment survey of the same year.

III

Figures of that years Employment survey were considerably lesser due to non-response under coverage as well as the ethnic disturbances that prevailed in July 1983. Even the Sample Survey does not portray a true picture as the sample selections are based on the frame of the Employment Survey. In two Industries Mining and Quarrying and Electricity the employment shows a decline when compared with the Employment Survey figures. This is probably due to only a few establishments of these industries being reflected in the Sample.

Table 2 gives the monthly Wage bill by Industries(Both sectors combined) for June 83. According the percentage distribution of the Wage bill,Agriculture constitutes nearly one fourth; Manufacturing 23.5%;Finance 13.5%; and trade 12% respectively. When the Total bill is compared with that of June '77,an increase of 144.5% is seen. The wage Bill for June 83 was Rs 63.2 Million as against Rs25.8 million in June '77.However there dose not appear to be a significant difference in the number employed in the two periods '83 and '77. This clearly shows that the wages and salaries of workers have increased rapidly over the past years.

IV

Table III & IV gives the Index Numbers of Earnings by Major Industry divisions and by Occupational categories respectively. Laspeyres' formula was used to calculate the Index numbers of Earnings by keeping the base year as September 1974. Index Numbers by Industries except Agriculture have been on the higher side in comparison with June 82. But in the case of Agriculture the figure has fallen. It could be due to an error in the final printout which was not traceable. Salary & wage increases on a number of occasions resulted in increases of the index numbers. The percentage rise from March '75 to June '83 (last column of table) shows the highest increase in Financing, & Insurance, than Construction; and Agriculture industries. Indexes by Major occupations (Table iv) show the highest in Unskilled 365.4 while the lowest in Professional & Technical 263.0. The percentage increase since march '75 to JUNE '83 by Major Occupational Categories, shows the highest in Unskilled 209.7%; then skilled and & Semi-skilled 179.2%. In the Occupation, Sales, the Figures were deleted from the table due to fluctuations of Earnings over past years.

Table V & VI give the average earnings for Public, Private and Both sectors combined by major Industry Division & Major Occupational categories for June '77 & '83.

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In comparison Wages & Salaries have increased in all sectors (Private, Public and Both combined) According to the figures of June 77 & 83, the public sector shows an increase of 168.6% while the private sector is 147.8% and both sectors combined is 166.4%.
