PREFACE

First Annual Employment Survey Report was published in 1971. This is the fifteenth report in the series since then. This Survey was started with the assistance of UNDP / ILO for the development of Labour Statistics in Sri Lanka. The Survey covers establishments having five or more paid employees and engaged in productive, distributive business and commercial activities in both the Private and Public Sectors. Since there is no complete list of business establishment for the country, coverage of the Survey is far below the real situation. Although quite a large number of establishments were addressed, non-response rate has been increasing year by year.

The Survey is conducted by post taking the last working day of the month of June of the particular year as the reference period. Although high non-response rates are influencing the total figures, other important characteristics such as changing employment pattern among the different industries, male-female participation or increasing female participation from unskill to Administration Managerial and Professional, Technical grades, the Survey findings highlight country's current economic trend.

Planning of this Survey, execution and preparation of final statistical tables were carried out by Mrs. D.L. Liyanage, Statistical Officer with her staff of the Annual Employment Survey Unit of the Statistics Division of this Department under the direction and guidance of Mr. A. Kahanda, Labour Statistician. Mr. Kahanda was also responsible for the preparation of this Final Report.

Messrs. D. Callyanaratne and P. D. P. Namaldeniya who were attached to this Division and Mr. Nimal Gunasinghe, Statistical Officers were also associated with this work in addition to their normal work.

The staff of the Data Processing Division of the Department of Census and Statistics was responsible for processing the data.

Finally, I express my gratitude to all employers who responded to Survey with their valuable co-operation in furnishing the data.

INTRODUCTION :

This is the fifteenth report in the series on Annual Employment Survey since 1971 conducted by the Statistics Division of the Department of Labour. The main objective of the Survey was to collect the information on employment by industry and occupation from all the establishments with five or more paid employees in the Private Sector and the manufacturing and service institutions coming under Public Sector. Annual Employment Survey, 1971 was the first in the series and all the establishments and estates with five or more paid employees were taken for the Survey. This list was collected by the Department of Census and Statistics in 1970 along with the Pre-listing form of the 1971 Census of Population and Housing (F1 Form), wherein address, type of activity and the employment had been recorded. But since then a complete list of such information was not available and the Survey frame was not updated in one count. Several attempts were made to have complete enumeration of business establishment with a assistance of the Department of Census and Statistics, but due to not availability of financial resources it was abandoned. Every year some addition were made to frame from the new registration of the Employees' Provident Funds contributors, but this is not sufficient to keep the frame in satisfactory level. Data of the Annual Employment Surveys of 1985 and 1986 were included in fourteenth report. Survey for 1987 were not conducted due to unavoidable reasons. This report gives the 1988 and 1989 Annual Employment Surveys findings. Civil disturbances prevail in the country during the latter part of 1989 was badly affected to all the stages of the 1989, Survey.

As in the previous years the reference period for the Survey continued to be the last working day in the month of June of that year.

ANALYSIS OF SURVEY RESULTS :

Due to several reasons, Survey organization work was badly affected. Frequent transferring of office staff in and out from the division was very badly affected to this work. This position is clearly evidence from the Survey results. Total number of establishments addressed were declined drastically during last two Surveys. Total number of establishments addressed in 1984 was 16,737 and this was declined to 9,600 in 1988 and 8,668 in 1989. Table 1:1 and 1:2 below shows this picture clearly. Out of these establishments addressed, number of eligible establishments were 7,186 in 1988 and 6,068 in 1989. As a result of this declined, number of reporting establishments also declined drastically. In 1986 Survey, there were 12,897 establishments addressed and this was declined to 8,668 in 1989 by 32.8 per cent. Whereas number of reporting establishments has declined from 6,645 in 1986 to 3,225 in 1989 by 47.0 per cent.

As compare to 1989 Survey, Annual Employment Survey 1988 covered more establishments. Although it shows less establishments as well as employment with compare to previous year (1986), but it covered more establishments and employment both Private and Public Sectors as against to 1989. As shown in Table 2 below, employment coverage in Private Sector was all time high, 38.53 per cent in 1988 whereas 1989 it was 26.06 per cent. Proportion employed in Private Sector increased gradually since 1977.

More employment oriented establishments in Public Sector such as, Departments of Marketing Development, High Way, Building, Textiles etc. were closed down or reduces their activities and also some of the Public Sector Corporations / Boards, closed down or reduced their activities. This was the main reason to show decline trend in Public Sector employment. With the implementation of Government open economy policy and transferring Government establishment to Private Sector, Public Sector employment will be decline further in near future.

INDEX NUMBER OF EMPLOYMENT :

Index numbers are widely use to monitor the trends in employment field as well as other sectors of the economy. Due to high non-response from the establishment, it is very difficult to obtain a list of common establishment submits the returns every year. Under these conditions Index number of link relative method could be use to study the employment pattern for each industry division. It has been evident on experience that the better organised establishment with larger work forces continue to respond regularly over the years. Hence for computational purposes of Index numbers, establishments which responded over two connective years were matched each time. Taking 1971 as base year, link relative method has been adopted in computation an Index of Employment for each major industry division. Index numbers were calculated by dividing the employment of current year by the corresponding figure for the previous year for each major industry division and then linking up by multiplying by the previous year Index.

Table No. 3 gives the Index Number of employment by major industry division and sectors for the period of 1985 to 1989 (excluding 1987). It shows over all Index Numbers for both sectors (Public and Private) combined was 116.5 and 116.9 for the years 1988 and 1989 respectively. It shows index has declined by 6.0 per cent from 1986 - 1988 and then it has increased slightly by 0.3 per cent from 1988 to 1989. As shown in Table No. 3, this picture is different for Private Sector. For Private Sector over all index has gone up by 51.0 per cent, from 1986 to 1989 and also further 1.0 per cent from 1988 to 1989, but Public Sector over all index has declined by 25.0 per cent from 1986 - 1988 and remained same in 1989. A more detail look into the Index Numbers of the major industry division shows this differences very clearly. In Private Sector index for major division Agriculture, Hunting, Forestry and Fishing has gone up by 57.0 per cent from 1986 - 1988 and index for Wholesale and Retail Trade, Restaurants and Hotels has gone up by 69.0 per cent, and also major group Financial Insurance, Real Estate and Business has shows highest increased by 78.0 per cent. In the case of major division on Construction index has gone up by 73.0 per cent for the Private Sector where as Public Sector index has declined by 24.0 per cent for the same period. As explained above this is mainly due to handing over Government Construction Work to Private Sector.

Table No. 4 gives more detail analysis of the trends for 1988 and 1989 taking common establishments which furnished returns for both years. During the period under consideration (1988 and 1989) Survey result were badly affected due to high under coverage and high non responder rate. As shown in Table No. 4 some notable increases were reported in coconut cultivation 7.95 per cent, Wholesale Trade 15.30 per cent, Retail Trade 6.85 per cent, Financial Institutions 9.55 per cent. Similarly notable declined are shown on Mining and Quarrying 23.07 per cent, Manufacture of Wood and Cork Products 41.69 per cent, Manufacture of Non-metallic Mineral Products 14.42 per cent.

DISTRIBUTION OF EMPLOYMENT :

Distribution of employment in summerised form by major Occupational and Industrial categories and sectors are given in Table No. 5 and 6 separately. Table No. 5 shows distribution of employees by industries where it shows clear indication of current employment pattern in economy. Per cent engage in Agriculture are declining gradually where as employment share in Manufacturing are gradually increasing. There was 20.81 per cent engage in Manufacturing in 1984 and this has gone upto 21.64 per cent in 1985, 22.4 per cent in 1986 and 26.0 per cent in 1988. Due to very poor coverage and responses in 1989 this distribution pattern was not shown properly.

Table No. 6 gives employment by major occupational categories. As shown in this Table majority of employees are coming under major category Un-skilled Worker and this is slowly but gradually declining over the period of times. Skilled and Semi-skilled category one increasing significantly with the expanding of economy in the country these changes of employment pattern are taking place. This is clearly evidence with the upward trends of first two major categories. Administrative and Managerial and Professional, Technical and Related Workers share are slowly increasing over the period of time.

Employment distribution by industry, occupations and sectors are discussed in previous sections and this section attention will be focus to employment distribution by gender and how females gained their share in economic activity within the developing economy. Table No. 7 shows percentage distribution of employees by gender, and sectors. It evidenced how females gained their share in economy. As shown is previous Surveys total female participation was 35.93 per cent in 1984 and 36.65 per cent in 1985 and this has gone upto 41.8 per cent in 1988. This gives 16.3 per cent increase from 1984 to 1988. It shows more and more women are participating in economic activities in Organised Sector.

Further analysis on Survey data are shown in Table No. 8, 9, 10.1 and 10.2 in respect of female employment in Organised Sector. Table No. 8 given number and percentage of women employees to total employees (men and women) by major industry division. Female employment in Manufacturing has increased by 30.2 per cent from 1984 - 1988 while from 1986 - 1988 it has gone up by 8.8 per cent. Major divisions, Wholesale & Retail Trade and Restaurants and Hotels are shown 35.3 per cent female employment increased from 1984 - 1988, whereas from 1986 - 1988 this was increased by 27.8 per cent. Table 9 gives further analysis of same female employment data by major occupational categories. It shows percentage of female employees to total employees are increasing significantly in major occupational categories such as Administration and Managerial, Professional Technical & Related and Clerical & Related Workers. This share in Professional, Technicals Related Workers category has gone up by 58.2 per cent from 1985 to 1988. This increased from 1986 - 1988 was 47.3 per cent.
