P R E F A C E

With the objective of improvement of Labour Statistics in Sri Lanka, the Statistics Division of the Department of Labour started conducting the annual employment survey in 1971. The present report "EMPLOYMENT SURVEY - 1992" is the eighteenth in the series since 1971. The survey covers establishment having five or more paid employees and engaged in productive, distributive business and commercial activities in both the Private and Public Sectors. The total coverage of establishments specially in Private Sector is very low due to non-availability of complete list of establishments (frame) and the high non-response rate. Therefore it is felt that the final solution would be a complete census of establishments to overcome this problem.

The survey is conducted by post, having taken the last working day of the month of June of the corresponding year as the reference period. Although factors such as under coverage and high non-response rate have influenced the total figures, other important characteristics such as changing employment pattern in the economy, distribution of employment among different industries or gender distribution by occupation and industries in the organized sector are some of the important findings of the survey.

The planning and execution of this survey was carried out by Mr. H. D. R. G. Peiris, Statistical Officer and the staff of the Employment Survey Unit of the Statistics Division under the guidance and direction of the Deputy Director (Statistics), Mr. A. Kahanda. Mr. D. G. S. G. Munasinghe, Statistician was also associated with the preparation of report.

The staff of the Data Processing Division of the Department of Census and Statistics was responsible for data processing.

Finally, I wish to express my appreciation to all employers who have responded to this survey and for their co-operation to its successful completion.

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ANNUAL EMPLOYMENT SURVEY - 1992

I

INTRODUCTION

This is the eighteenth in the series of the Annual Employment Survey conducted by the Statistics Division of the Department of Labour. First Survey of this nature was conducted in 1971, with the objective of collecting information on employment by industry and occupation from all the establishments in the country with five or more paid employees in the Private Sector and from the manufacturing and services institutions of the Public Sector. Though this is a "Postal type Survey", the indications have been proved the inadequacy of the frame, since the frame has not been updated after 1971. This might shows the low number of employment figures than the existing number of employment in the organized sector.

OBJECTIVE

To collect statistical Data on Employment in Organized Sector by industry and occupation with a view to build up an index of Employment and to watch employment trends of the Economy.

ANALYSIS OF SURVEY RESULTS

The total number of establishments addressed in 1992 was 6242. This shows 15.5 percent declined in number addressed, compare to the year 1991 which was 7384. On the contrary the improvements of response rate in survey has been increased to 77.2 percent in 1992, with compare to 75.8 percent in 1991. (see Table No. 1)

As shown in Table No. II below coverage of establishments as well as employment was declined in 1992, compared to previous two years. Employment coverage in Private Sector has reached to 235288, which was all times high and was 36.4 percent to the total employment. With the implementation of government's open economic policy and transferring Government Business establishment to Private Sector would have strengthened the Private Sector share in economy. Increasing trend of employees in Private Sector is seen over the past fourteen years.

INDEX NUMBER OF EMPLOYMENT

Index numbers are widely use to monitor the trends in employment field as well as other sectors of the economy. Due to high non-response from the establishment, it is very difficult to obtain a list of common establishment submits the returns every year. Under these conditions Index number of link relative method could by use to study the employment pattern for each industry division. It has been evident on experience that the better organized establishment with larger work forces continue to respond regularly over the years. Hence for computational purpose of Index numbers, establishments which responded over two consecutive years were matched each time. Taking 1971 as base year, link relative method has been adopted in computation an Index of Employment for each major industry division. Index numbers were calculated by dividing the employment of current year by the corresponding figure for the previous year for each major industry division and then linking up by multiplying by the previous year index.

Table No. III shows the Index number of Employment by major industry division and sector for the period of 1988 to 1992. As shown in table, all Index number for both sectors (Public and Private) combined has declined from 120. 1 in 1991 to 97. 0 in 1992. This decline was more significant in Public Sector and Index has gone down by 24 % percent from 131. 7 percent in 1991 to 100. 5 percent in 1992. Industry wise breakdown of the Index number shows, 48. 7 percent decreased for both sectors in Transport, Storage and Communication divisions and the change (decrease) would have caused more effect from Public Sector, as it shows 46. 8 percent decreased from 1991 (163. 0 %) to 1992 (86. 6 %). This declined in Public Sector employment in transport industry was mainly due to reduction of employment in the Sri Lanka Transport Board with the popularization of the Depts. Where in Private Sector it has gone up by 7. 7 percent from 148. 2 percent in 1991 to 159. 7 percent in 1992. Manufacturing Sector shows 11. 8 percent decrease for both sectors, Private and Public Sectors shows 12. 9 percent and 23 percent declines respectively. Index for Construction Sector has declined by 20. 9 percent from 1991 to 1992 for both sectors while Private Sector shows 27. 8 percent decreased from 1991 to 1992 and Public Sector shows 19 percent decreased for the same period. Overall Index number as well as the industry wise break-down of the Index numbers show the similar trend (decreasing) in Public Sector whereas in the Private Sector shows different trends.

Table No. IV gives more detail analysis of the employment trends for the year 1991 and 1992. Taking the establishments which furnished returns for both years (1991 - 1992) this tabulation were made. As shown in this table - 29.6 percent employment decrease were reported for all economic activities. The figure for the Private Sector was - 54.1 percent. Both Private and Public Sector show the negative trend. But the Private Sector shows the high negative trend as - 54.1 percent, whereas Public Sector shows the low negative as + 13.5 percent. This was mainly due to poor response rate.

DISTRIBUTION OF EMPLOYMENT

Employment distribution by industry and occupation will be a good indicator to shows country's changing economic pattern. It will highlight the trends of economy such as movement of employment from agriculture sector to other sectors such as Manufacturing, Construction or Business Services etc., The Table V and VI gives percentage distribution of employment according to major industry division and occupational categories by sector.

country. Employment share in Agricultural Sector declining rapidly over the years from 1990 to 1992. It was 42.0 percent 1990 and declined to 40.3 percent in 1992.

Table VI gives, employment distribution by occupational categories. Percentage distribution of employees by sex and sectors are shown in Table VII. It shows that the female participation in organized sector has increased significantly. This increase are more significant in Private Sector with compare to Public Sector. Percentage female employees in Private Sector was 55.1 percent in 1990 and this has gone upto 59.3 percent in 1992. Corresponding figure for Public Sector was 37.7 percent and 39.0 percent respectively.

Number and percentage distribution of women employees to total employees (men and women) by major division of industry and by major occupation categories are shown in table VIII, IX and X. As shown in Table VII, number and percentage of women employees in Manufacturing Sector has increased significantly from 33.9 percent in 1989 to 60.5 percent in 1992. Number also gone up from 37,004 in 1989 to 121,936 in 1992. This is mainly due to employment increases in Textile and Garment Trades. Also these female employment increases are shown in Construction, Wholesale & Retail, Finance, Insurance, Real Estate & Business Services and Personal Services.

Table IX gives further breakdown of female employees distribution by major occupational categories. As seen on this Table almost all the occupational categories, proportion of female employed increased. Professional, Technical and Related category has increased from 24. 3 percent in 1989 to 24. 5 in 1992. Also Skilled and Semi-skilled category has increased from 32. 8 percent to 51. 4 percent in 1992. During this period female employment coverage of the Survey has gone up by 46. 8 percent.

Table X gives number and percentage of women employees by Major Industry and Occupational categories. This Table shows total employees and the percentage female employees for each cross classification group. According to this Table under the Manufacturing Industry, out of total employees in Skilled and Semi-skilled, Occupational categories 66. 7 percent are female. Under the industry group Construction, 14. 5 percent Un-skilled workers are female.
