P R E F A C E

The Annual Employment Survey of the Department of Labour was designed to measure the levels and trends of employment in the organized sector in Sri Lanka on a continuous basis. This survey is conducted annually commencing from the year 1971. The present "Employment Survey - 1994" report is the twentieth in the series since then. The survey covers establishments having five or more paid employees and engaged in productive, distributive, business and commercial activities in both the Public and Private Sectors. The coverage of the survey specially in the Private Sector is very low due to non-availability of complete list of establishments (frame) and also of the high non-response rate.

The Survey is conducted by post, having taken the last working day of the month of June of the corresponding year as the reference period. Although under-coverage and non-response rate are the main factors which influenced the total figures, other important characteristics such as the change in the economic pattern in the economy, distribution of employment among different industries and gender distribution by occupation and industry in the organized sector are some of the important findings of the survey.

An attempt is made in publishing this report by using MicroComputers with the assistance of the staff of the Labour Statistics Division. The Data Processing Division of the Department of Census and Statistics was responsible for data processing work. However due to the power cut prevailed during the middle part of the year the data processing work got held up resulting a delay in publishing this report.

Planning and execution of this survey was carried out by Mr. H. D. R. G. Peiris, Statistical Officer and the staff of the Employment Survey Unit of the Statistics Division and Mr. M.B.M. Alwis, Statistician was responsible for organising and preparation of this final report under the guidance and direction of Mr. A. Kahanda Deputy Director (Statistics).

Finally, I wish to express my appreciation to all employees who responded to the survey and for their co-operation for the successful completion of the survey.

ANNUAL EMPLOYMENT SURVEY-1994

INTRODUCTION

The Annual Employment Survey first started in 1971 with the objective of collecting the information on employment by industry and occupation covering all the establishments in Sri Lanka with five or more paid employees in the Public and Private sector. This is the twentieth in the series of the Annual Employment Survey. This being a postal survey and has been being conducted every year since its inception and the reference period of the survey continued to be the last full working day in the month of June of that year. Though this is a postal survey indications have been proved the inadequacy of the frame, since the frame has not been updated completely after 1971, where a complete list of establishments was collected along with pre-listing schedule of the 1971 census of population and housing. Even though to minimise the under coverage some additions were made to the survey frame from the new registrations of employees provident fund contributors every year, itself is insufficient to achieve a satisfactory level.

SCOPE AND OBJECTIVE

The main objective of the survey is to collect statistical data on employment in organized sector by industry and occupation with an aim to build up an index of employment and to watch the employment trends of the economy. The coverage of the survey will be all the establishments with five or more paid employees in the Private Sector and the manufacturing and services institutions coming under the Public Sector.

ANALYSIS OF SURVEY RESULTS

Table 1 gives the analysis of response for the year 1994. The total number of establishments addressed in 1994 was 6381 and it shows 21.4 percent decline in the number addressed in comparison with that of year 1993 which amounts to 8116. Table 1 further reveals that the number of eligible establishments out of the 6381 establishments addressed in 1994 there were 1417 establishments outside the scope of the survey of that 1215 are closed or duplicate and 202 were nil or less than five employees. It also reveals that the number of eligible establishments were 5964 of that 4215 establishments submitted their forms which shows a slight decrease over the previous figure of 4541 in 1993. Anyhow the overall response rate has increased to 82.2 percent in 1994, with compared to 71.4 percent in 1993.

as shown in Table 11 the employment coverage in 1994 rose to 792,976 which is an increase of 8.8 percent over the previous year. The employment coverage in Private Sector has reached 382,045 which is all times high and the corresponding share of employment in the Private Sector has also risen from 44.7 percent in 1993 to 48.2 percent in 1994. The continuation of Government implementation of open economic policies and transferring of Government business establishments to Private Sector which would have increased in the Private Sector share in economy may be the reason for this.

INDEX NUMBER OF EMPLOYMENT

Index numbers are commonly used in any field of economy to monitor the changing trends since it is accepted that the index numbers are the best indicators to monitor the trends. Hence to monitor the change of employment of the economy from year to year as a whole from year to year as well as major industry division of employment is been used. Total employment obtain from the survey findings are not suitable to compute the index number of employment due to change of response from year to year. Therefore it was decided to use the employment in common establishment which supply the data between two adjacent years to compute this index. Normally better organized establishments with large employment continued to respond regularly over the the years. Therefore for the computation of the index number of employment, the establishments which responded over two adjoining years were matched each year.

Taking 1971=100 as base year link relative method has been adopted for computation an index of employment for each major industry division. These index numbers were calculated by dividing the current year employment by the corresponding figure for the previous year for each major industry division and then linking up by multiplying by the previous year index. This method has been adopted over the years since 1971.

Table 111 shows the index number of employment by major industry division and sector for the period of 1991 to 1994. As shown in the table, index number for both sectors (Public and Private) has increased by 3.9 percent from 108.5 to 112.4 percent. The corresponding increases in the Private Sector and Public Sector were 7.1 percent and 2.6 percent respectively. Detail analysis of major industry division wise breakdown of index numbers reveals 38.5 and 91.3 percent increase for Both Sectors and Public Sector respectively in Transport, Storage and Communication division and in Private Sector it shows a decrease of 11.1 percent. Employment index for Electricity, gas and Water industry division has also gone up by 22.9 percent for Both Sectors (Public and Private) during this period. It has increased by 24.2 and 4.8 percent in the Public Sector and Private Sector respectively. In the case of Construction industry also the employment index has gone up by 21.6 percent for Both Sectors. The Corresponding increases for Public Sector and private sector were 15.0 and 2.8 percent for the period of 1993 and 1994.

Table iv gives more detailed industry wise analysis of the employment trends for the years 1993 and 1994, taking the establishments which furnished returns for both years. As shown in this table only 3.4 percent employment increase was reported for all the economic activities. The corresponding figures for the Public and Private Sectors were 2.3 percent and 4.7 percent respectively. It also reveals that most of the industries in the private sector shows a positive trend.

DISTRIBUTION OF EMPLOYMENT

Employment distribution by industry and occupation is an important indicator that shows the country's changing economic pattern. The Table v shows the percentage distribution of employment by major division of industry. The Table reveals that the declining trend of employment share in Agriculture sector become static and has reached a figure around 40 percent. On the other hand the Manufacturing Sector has grown up by absorbing more employment and has reached a level around 35 percent.

Table vi gives employment distribution by occupational category. As seen in this Table almost one half of employees are coming from the unskilled major occupational category. The skilled and semiskilled category also accounts to more than one fourth of the total.

Percentage distribution of employees by sex and sector are given in Table vii. The female participation rate in the organized sector shows a slight increase during the period 1992 to 1994. The percentage of female employees in both Public and Private Sector was 46.4 percent in 1992 and this has gone up to 48.2 percent in 1994. The male participation rate has increased slightly from 1993 to 1994.

It is observed from the Table viii the female participation in the organized sector is increasing gradually. This increase is more significant in manufacturing sector mainly due to women being employed in the Textile and Garment Trades and the proportion of female to that of total employees (men and women) in this sector has risen from 57.6 percent in 1991 to 60.1 percent in 1994.

Table ix gives a further breakdown of female employees distribution by major occupational category. As observed from this Table it is evident that almost all the occupational categories, the proportion of female employees has increased. The skilled and semiskilled category has risen from 48.9 percent to 54.0 percent during the period 1991 to 1994. The female employment coverage has also risen to 48.2 percent from 43.8 percent during the same period.

Table x gives number and percentage of women employees by major industry and occupational category. It is observed that under the Manufacturing Industry out of the total employees in skilled and semiskilled occupational category accounts to 67.5 percent female and the unskilled category in the same division of industry claims to have 62.0 percent as female. This is mainly due to the fact that engagement of women employees in the Textile and Garment Industry.
