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## PREFACE

Annual Employment Survey was designed to measure the levels and trends of employment in the organized sector, in private sector as well as in the semi government sector of Sri Lankan economy over a period of time. This survey has been conducted annually since 1971 by the Statistics Division of the Department of Labour and this is the twenty eighth publication in the series. The survey covers establishments with five or more paid employees engaged in production, distribution and other commercial activities in both private and public sectors. Data is collected by using postal survey method. In access to limitations of a complete list of establishments for the whole country, collection of data through a postal questionnaire has been the main drawback on the coverage of this survey.

Distribution of organized sector employment by major divisions of industry, change of employment by divisions of industry over a period of the time and also gender distribution by industry are some of the major findings of the survey.

Planning and the execution of the survey was done by Mr. H.D.R.G. Peiris, Statistician and the staff of the Statistics Division with the assistance of Mr. D.N. Jayakodige, Senior Statistician under the guidance and directions of Mr. P.V.C. Perera, Deputy Director who was responsible for the preparation of the final report.

Data processing activities, printing of the cover page and final compilation of this publication were handled by the respective Divisions of the Department of Census & Statistics.

I extend my sincere thanks to all officials who have contributed unreservedly to this survey and publication of the report.

Finally, I wish to express my great appreciation to all employers who have responded to our request and for their co-operation for the successful accomplishment of this endeavour.



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## ANNUAL EMPLOYMENT SURVEY – 2002

### INTRODUCTION

The Annual Employment Survey is conducted since 1971 by the Statistics Division of the Department of Labour to measure the levels and trends of employment in Organized Sector of the economy. This is the 28<sup>th</sup> publication in the series of "Employment Survey". The Survey covers establishments with 5 or more paid employees in Private Sector and also semi-government Institutions in Public Sector. Coverage of survey affected due to limits of comprehensive list of establishment with postal addresses.

Reference period for the survey was taken as last working day in the month of June of the year 2002.

### ANALYSIS OF THE SURVEY RESPONSE

Table I shows details of responses of 7466 establishments that were addressed for the survey. Out of that 596 establishments were reported as closed or less than five employees. Therefore out of the 6870 eligible establishments only 4886 establishments had sent their completed returns and 1984 had not been responded. Accordingly non-response rate was 28.9 percent. This is some what achievement in this kind of surveys. Table 1 below brings response analysis.

According to survey findings 30.2 percent establishments and 32.9 percent employees were reported from Colombo District. This was 30.8 percent and 30.0 percent respectively in the previous survey year. Gampaha district shows second highest as 10.0 percent establishments and 11.1 percent in employment. Comparative figure for 2001 was 12.4 and 19.9 percent respectively. As shown in Table II, 47.0 percent establishments and 49.5 percent employees were reported from Western Province.

Corresponding figures for 2001 were 50.1 percent and 55.7 percent. According to 2000 survey this share was 44.6 percent and 50.6 percent respectively. This shows majority of establishments and employment of the organized sector of the economy are concentrating in Western Province.

As shown in Table III Economic Activities of Private Sector is being increasing gradually. The Employment share in 1992 was 36.4 percent and it has increased to 64.5 percent in year 2002. Corresponding Public Sector share has been declined.

Table IV shows the Index Number of Employment by Major Industry Division and sector from the year 1999 to 2002. There is an increasing trend in the index mainly in Transport storage and Communication category during the reference period. Whereas Wholesale & Retail Trade shows a major decrease in both the public and private sectors. .

## DISTRIBUTION OF EMPLOYMENT

Table VI and VII shows employment distribution by major division of industries and by major occupational categories. Employment share of the major division of Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing has been increasing from 24.2 percent in 2001 to 28.4 percent in 2002. The number of employment in manufacturing sector has been declined from 40.3 percent in 2001 to 30.5 percent in 2002. As shown in Table VII employment distribution by major occupational categories, "unskilled workers" shows declining trend from 35.8 in 2000 to 31.6 percent in 2002. Administrative and Managerial as well as Clerical and Related workers categories are showing increasing trends.

## GENDER DISTRIBUTION

According to survey findings female workers are dominating in Agriculture and Manufacturing Industry Divisions as 50.9 and 55.7 percent respectively. Next higher woman participation Industry groups are Personal Service 32.7 percent, Finance, Insurance Services 31.2 percent, Finance, Wholesale and Retail Sales 30.2 percent.

Table IX shows number and percentage of woman employees to total employees by major occupational categories. The data shows highest percentage of female participation when related to other occupational categories, in skilled and semi skilled groups as 48.4 percent and unskilled group as 45.7 percent. Clerical and Related category also reported as 37.5 percent female employees.

Table X shows a cross-classification of woman employees by major industry division and major occupational categories. It shows the highest women participation in Manufacturing Groups is skilled and semi skilled workers as 65.3 percent.

Next highest female participation was reported amongst unskilled in Manufacturing Group. This is mainly due to females are mostly concentrated in garment and textile industries.
