## PREFACE

Annual Employment Survey is designed to measure the levels and trends of employment in the organized sector, private sector as well as in the semi government sector of Sri Lankan economy. This survey has been conducted annually since 1971 by the Statistics Division of the Department of Labour and this is the twenty ninth publication in the series. The survey covers establishments with five or more paid employees engaged in production, distribution and other commercial activities in both private and semi government sectors. Data is collected by using postal survey method. In additions to limitations of a complete list of establishments for the country, poor response to the postal questionnaire has been the main drawback on the coverage of this survey.

Distribution of organized sector employment by major divisions of industry, change of employment by division of industry over a period of the time and also gender distribution by industry are some of the major findings of the survey.

Planning and the execution of the survey was done by Mr. M.D. Weerasinghe & Mr. H.D.N. Padmasiri Statisticians and the staff of the Statistics Divisions with the assistance of Mr. D.N. Jayakodige, Senior Statistician under the guidance and directions of Mr. P.V.C. Perera, Deputy Director who was responsible for the preparation of the final report.

Data processing activities, printing of the cover page and final compilation of this publication were handled by the respective Division of the Department of Census & Statistics.

I extend my sincere thanks to all officials who have contributed unreservedly to this survey and publication of the report.



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## ANNUAL EMPLOYMENT SURVEY – 2003

### INTRODUCTION

The Annual Employment Survey is conducted since 1971 by the Statistics Division of the Department of Labour to measure the levels and trends of employment in Organized Sector of the economy. This is the 29<sup>th</sup> publication in the series of "Employment Survey". The Survey covers establishments with 5 or more paid employees in Private Sector and also semi-government Institutions in Public Sector. Coverage of survey affected due to limits of comprehensive list of establishment with postal addresses. High non responses due to collection of information through post, has influenced survey results to some extent.

Reference period for the survey was taken as last working day in the month of June of the year 2003.

### ANALYSIS OF THE SURVEY RESPONSE

Table I shows details of responses of 9974 establishments that were addressed for the survey. Out of that 847 establishments were reported as closed or less than five employees. Therefore out of the 9127 eligible establishments only 5359 establishments had sent their completed returns and 3768 had not been responded. Accordingly non-response rate was 41.3 percent. This is some what achievement in this kind of surveys. Table I below brings response analysis.

According to survey findings 28.9 percent establishments and 30.5 percent employees were reported from Colombo District. This was 30.2 percent and 32.9 percent respectively in the previous survey year. Gampaha district shows second highest as 10.1 percent establishments and 10.6 percent in employment. Comparative figure for 2002 was 10.0 and 11.1 percent respectively. As shown in Table II, 46.3 percent establishments and 47.5 percent employees were reported from Western Province.

Corresponding figures for 2002 were 46.9 percent and 49.5 percent. According to 2001 survey this share was 50.1 percent and 55.7 percent respectively. This shows majority of establishments and employment of the organized sector of the economy are concentrating in Western Province.

As shown in Table III Economic Activities of Private Sector is being increasing gradually. The Employment share in 1993 was 44.7 percent and it has increased to 70.2 percent in year 2003. Corresponding Public Sector share has been declined.

### **DISTRIBUTION OF EMPLOYMENT**

Table VI and VII high light the employment distribution by major industry division and major occupational categories. Employment share of the major division of Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing has being decreasing from 28.4 percent in 2002 to 26.9 percent in 2003. The number of employment in manufacturing sector has declined from 42.4 percent in 2002 to 36.5 percent in 2003. As shown in Table VII employment distribution by major occupational categories. "unskilled workers" shows declining trend from 31.6 in 2002 to 28.9 percent in 2003. Administrative and Managerial as well as Professional, Technical & Related workers categories are showing increasing trends.

## GENDER DISTRIBUTION

According to survey findings female workers are dominating in Agriculture and Manufacturing Industry Divisions as 51.6 and 63.4 percent respectively. Next higher woman participation Industry groups are mining & quarrying 44.7 percent, Finance, Insurance Services 32.8 percent, Wholesale and Retail Sales 29.7 percent.

Table IX shows number and percentage of woman employees to total employees by major occupational categories. The data shows highest percentage of female participation when related to other occupational categories, in skilled and semi skilled groups as 56.9 percent and unskilled group as 49.9 percent. Clerical and Related category also reported as 42.5 percent female employees.

Table X shows a cross-classification of woman employees by major industry division and major occupational categories. It shows the highest women participation in Manufacturing Groups is skilled and semi skilled workers as 71.6 percent.

Next highest female participation was reported amongst unskilled in Manufacturing Group. This is mainly due to females are mostly concentrated in garment and textile industries.
