PREFACE

Annual Employment Survey is designed to measure the levels and trends of employment in the Organized Sector, Private Sector as well as the Semi Government Sector of Sri Lankan economy over a period of time. This survey has been conducted annually since 1971 by the Statistics Division of the Department of Labour and this is the 31st publication in the series. The survey covers establishments with five or more paid employees engaged in productive, distributive business and other commercial activities in both private and public sectors. Data are collected by using postal survey method. In addition to limitations of a complete list of establishments for the whole country, collection of data through a postal questionnaire has been the main drawback on the coverage of this survey.


Distribution of organized sector employment by major division of industry, change of employment by divisions of industry over a period of time and also gender distribution by industry are some of the major findings of the survey.

Finally, I express my appreciation to all employers who have responded to our request and for their co-operation for the success of this endeavour.



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

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ANNUAL EMPLOYMENT SURVEY – 2005

INTRODUCTION

The Annual Employment Survey is conducted since 1971 by the Statistics Division of the Department of Labour to measure the levels and trends of employment in Organized Sector of the economy. This is the 31st publication in the series of "Employment Survey". The Survey covers establishments with 5 or more paid employees in Private Sector and also semi-government Institutions in Public Sector. Coverage of the survey was affected due to the limits of postal addresses of the comprehensive list of establishments. Non responses due to heavy collection of information through post, has influenced the survey results to some extent.

Reference period for the survey was taken as last working day in the month of June of the year 2005.

ANALYSIS OF THE SURVEY RESPONSE

Table I depicts the details of responses of 9270 establishments that were addressed for the survey. Out of that 588 establishments were reported as closed, nil or less than five employees. Therefore out of the 8682 eligible establishments only 6232 establishments had sent their completed returns and 2450 had not been responded. Accordingly non-response rate was 28.22 percent. This is some level of achievement in this kind of surveys.

As shown in table II, 29 percent establishments and 31 percent employees were reported from Colombo District. Gampaha district becomes the second highest 12 percent employees are engaged. According to survey findings 48.2 percent establishments and 49.3 percent employees were reported from the western province. According to 2004 survey this share was 45.1 percent and 46.2 percent respectively.

Corresponding figures for 2003 were 46.3 percent and 47.7 percent. This shows the majority of establishments and employment of the organized sector of the economy are concentrating in Western Province.

Table III shows that the Establishments engaged in productive, distributive business and commercial activities under Ministries, Departments, Corporations, and Government owned business undertakings and Semi-Government Institutions are considered as public sector establishments. The lion's share of employment representing the Private Sector was increased up to 72 percent in 2005 from 55 percent in 1995. The corresponding figure of the public sector was decreased to 28 percent from 45 percent during the last decade.

Above table IV indicates the Index Number of Employment by Major Industry Division and Sector from the year 2002 to 2005. Index Number for All Industries has increased from 90.3 in 2004 to 98.3 in 2005. This increase was mainly due to employment changes of Private Sector where as Public Sector Index shows a negative trend from 2002 to 2005.

Table V shows calculated more details change in employment between 2004 and 2005 taking common establishments which furnished returns for both years. As shown in this table 1.9 percent employment increase indicated for all common establishment from year 2004 to 2005.

Table VI highlight the employment distribution by major industry divisions of the consecutive years 2003 - 2005. Each year about 60% of the employees concentrated to Agriculture Forestry & Fishing and Manufacturing major industry divisions

Table VII below shows the percentage distribution of Employees by Major Occupational Categories by sector for the years 2003 – 2005.

As shown in the table, there is a noticeable difference of the skilled and unskilled categories between the private and public sector. There are more manual workers in the private sector than its counterpart.

According to table VIII above, female workers are dominating in manufacturing and Agriculture Industry Divisions as 56.5 and 52.6 percent respectively. The next higher women participation is reported in Wholesale & Retail Trade which is 34.8 percent and Financing Insurance & Business services achieved 33.9 percent.

The table IX indicates the women employment by major occupational categories for the years 2002-2005. The highest concentration is in the skilled and semi skilled category and the least concentration is in the Foreman & Supervisors category in almost all the years. Year 2005 records the highest percentage of female participation related to the occupational categories in skilled and semi skilled groups as 51.3 percent and unskilled group 46.8 percent respectively. Clerical & related category also reported as 42.2 percent female employees.

The table X shows a cross-classification of woman employees by major industry division and major occupational categories. Under major industry division of Manufacturing out of total workers 56.4 percent are women. In the same industry group out of total employees in skilled and semi skilled category 64.6 percent are females and unskilled category 55.7 percent are females.
