

Office Edit Issues

Here are some guidelines for the office editing:

Responsibilities:

- a. The office editors should ensure that there is easy flow in data entry process.
- b. The office editors should use green pens to edit the data.
- c. Under no circumstances can the office editor make up answers.

HOUSEHOLD QUESTIONNAIRE:

1. Arrange all the household questionnaires (books) according to the SSU code.
2. Make sure to attach the eligible woman questionnaires together in the same SSU if there is more than one eligible woman.
3. Ensure that all geographic and interview information codes are completed on the cover sheet of the household questionnaire and that they are correct.
4. Check if the individual code of the team members is given. If not then please insert it in the given space for ID (3 digit codes).
5. Check that all members listed in the household schedule usually live in the household or slept in the household the previous night (or both). If the member neither slept in the household the previous night nor is a usual resident of the household then they should be removed from the household listing. In doing this, all references to line numbers within the household schedule and on the cover pages of the individual questionnaires must be adjusted accordingly. This also includes line numbers in the birth history and line numbers of husbands and wives. Additionally the total number of members listed on the cover page should be corrected.
6. Check that the total number of household members agrees with the number of members recorded in the household schedule.
7. The eligibility for the individual interview of each member of the household should be checked.

For each eligible person, their line number in the correct eligibility column should be circled. No other member of the household may have their line number circled in an eligibility column.

- The number of line numbers circled in column 11 should equal the number of eligible women on the cover sheet of the household questionnaire.
- The number of children circled in column 12 should equal the number of children in the Height/Weight section of the household questionnaire (if there are more than one eligible respondent then the next book for this information).

8. An individual questionnaire must exist for each eligible woman of the household, and for no other members.
 - If an eligible woman exists for whom there is no individual questionnaire, talk with your supervisor.
 - A questionnaire should be created for any eligible woman for whom no questionnaire exists. The result code should be '8- other' and the words 'questionnaire not returned from the field' should be written on the cover of the questionnaire. Be sure to correct the total number of eligible women on the cover of the household questionnaire if this is done.
9. Follow the skip pattern through the questionnaires to ensure that it is correctly used.
10. Change responses to missing where necessary by entering code '99'. In the questionnaire there are some places where missing code (99) is used in place of 'Don't know' code (98). Therefore, please change this to 98. A list of such places in the questionnaire where such changes are required is mentioned in the following table. Please refer to this table to make changes.
11. In the places where there are 'Other' category make sure the codes are '96'.

INDIVIDUAL QUESTIONNAIRE:

1. Ensure that each of the individual questionnaires is placed in ascending order of line number.
2. Ensure that the geographic and interview information codes are completed on the individual questionnaire cover page.
3. Once the questionnaire have been checked, one by one, and put into the correct order, the cluster of questionnaires should be checked against the control sheet returned from the field.
 - i. Each household and woman should be listed on the control sheet.
 - ii. The result code for each interview (household and women) should be marked on the control sheet.
 - iii. Check the correctness of each of the household and individual questionnaire (present, result code, selection for male sub-sample), one by one, and tick them off on the control sheet.
 - iv. Add to the control sheet any questionnaires you created because they were missing.
 - v. Strike from the control sheet any questionnaires you have removed because of ineligibility.
 - vi. Finally, tally the total number of households (complete and incomplete) and women (complete and incomplete) and write them on the cluster control sheet for data processing control.
4. Enter the proper occupation codes in the woman's questionnaire.
5. The codes for the brands of contraceptives should be entered.

6. Check that if there are no eligible women or there is a non-response from the woman's questionnaire then check that section 10 Q.1001 is asked.
7. Check that if it is marked on the sheet that there is an extra sheet for anthropometry then please check that it exists.
8. Also in case of children with no mother in the household check an extra sheet is attached.
9. If the section 10 is filled for more than one respondent then check for the missing individual and make it consistent. Take the first woman's questionnaire as the base and adjust in this questionnaire. If both have similar responses then cancel out the response in the second (or third) and consider the one in the first questionnaire. If it is not mentioned for a person in the first ER questionnaire then add from the second.
10. On the top of the Q1001 make a box and write the total number in the section 10.
11. Follow the skip pattern through the questionnaires to ensure that it is correctly used. Change responses to missing where necessary. Take into account the instruction as given in the household questionnaire guideline above.
12. If the skip in Q441 is not maintained and asked Q442 (YES) and then asked Q445 and Q446 then we cannot accept the response. The skip is not correct. If this happens then cancel Q442, Q445 and Q446.
13. If there is response in Q510 as A & B then do not accept this. Cancel it out. The entry program should not accept A and B.
