<u>Data Collection Notes</u> An enumerator for each Grama Niladhari Division and a supervisor for each group of 10 GN Divisions were appointed with the help of the District administration. The enumerator listed all the building units and collected the information visiting every building unit within the area allocated to him. Close supervision has been maintained throughout the enumeration by supervisors. The necessary administrative arrangement in the District were carried out by the District Secretary and Divisional Secretaries and all the technical guidance was provided by the staff of the Dept of Census and Statistics.
